### **Drennan (We are the Music Makers)**

Make sure there is a difference between a triplet which lasts a crotchet beat and triple which lasts over a minim beat.

Bar 82 - crescendo

Split for the final two bars is as follows:

Top stave - 1<sup>st</sup> sopranos sing the top B if you can, if not sing the G

2<sup>nd</sup> sopranos sing the top G

1<sup>st</sup> altos sing the D

2<sup>nd</sup> altos sing the B

Lower stave - All tenors sing the D Baritones sing the B Basses sing the G

### Whitacre (Seal Lullaby)

Turn pages as quietly as possible, especially page 5 into 6 and page 7 into 8.

Bar 68 – wait for the piano to play the two quavers on the last beat of the bar (after the pause) before the choir entry in bar 69.

# Gjeilo (Across the vast eternal sky)

Bar 37 – start the crescendo up to forte in bar 41.

Bar 39 – sopranos and 1<sup>st</sup> tenors – your B flat should be in unison.

# Stainer (God so Loved the World)

Bar 23 – basses watch your interval from the A to D (it's not the same as bar 60 which goes up to a B).

Watch the tuning from bars 33-37.

Keep the vowel sounds bright on the words "loved the world".

# **Stephens (Gloria!)**

Counting - make sure you know which bars are in 2/4 and which bars are in 3/4.
